- Abstract must not exceed 300 words and full length paper must not exceed 2500 words.
- Scientific Review Committee will review the submissions and convey the selection for either paper presentation or poster presentation by email within 5 days of submission.
- Posters should be designed in dimensions of 4 * 3 ft. OR 3 * 4 ft. max.
- Best Paper/Poster will be awarded.
- Selected papers shall be published in a UGC recognized, peer-reviewed journal (subject to review and acceptance as per the journal policy).
