

- Prospective Authors are invited to submit 1-Page Extended Abstracts by the deadline of Feb 05, 2025, using the google form/QR code.
- Each abstract should indicate appropriateness for the scope of the Conference, originality, and quality of the technical content and whole organization.
- The abstract should, moreover, explain the significance of the contribution and contain a list of key references.
- It must be prepared according to the template provided below (Title 14pt, main text 12pt, Headings in Bold, subheadings in italic, spacing 1.15, A4 size, Margins: 2.54 cm Top-Bottom and 1.91cm left-right).
- A submission implies a willingness to register and present the work if the abstract is accepted.
- Extended Abstracts will be reviewed by the Technical Program Committee.
- For <u>ONLINE MODE</u> additional 3 min video presentation of the work is to be submitted by <u>22nd Feb 2025</u>.

Poster Preparation

- Poster must correspond to the submitted abstract.
- Poster should be of the standard size (24" x 36")
- Plan your poster to be in logical sequence, i.e.
 introduction, study design and methods, data collected,
 results and discussion, conclusion, and selected
 references.
- To ensure visual effectiveness of your poster, please use large fonts, 16 and above. Use of colour can visually enhance your poster.
- The posters will be displayed on smooth boards and the use of drawing board pins to hold the posters is not permitted. Please plan to bring your own adhesive tape (preferably transparent) and cutting tool to fix the posters to the display boards.

Selected papers will be invited to be published in the peer reviewed/ UGC care listed/Scopus indexed (publication charges, as applicable) journals such as Engineered Science (<u>as per research area</u>), Sanshodhak, etc. after peer review.
